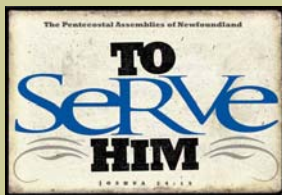

**Presenting 50+ Provincial Retreat**

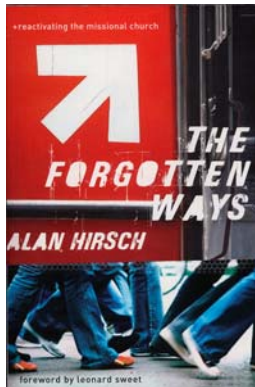
**"Return on HIS Investment"**

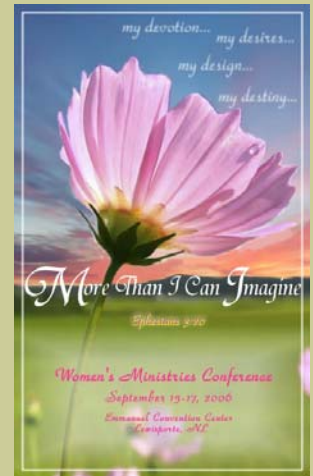


## Youth Ministries—Director: Brad Noel
