Nain is the largest community, and the largest centre for the Inuit nation on the coast of Labrador. It is the mostly northerly community in our province, approximately 25 kilometres north of the Voisey's Bay mine site. Its mixture of cultures, social issues and religious tradition make it a challenging area for ministry.

The Simms began their ministry with the Sub Arctic Mission in 1993 and pastored on the Dene Reserve in Hay River (1994-1997). In 1998-99 they ministered with PAONL as outreach pastors on the Northern Peninsula, from which they trained with the Anglican Church Army and worked in Tuktoyaktuk, Northwest Territories(1999-2004) and The Pas, Manitoba (2004-2008). They did fill-in ministry in the Hay River assembly before returning to the province in 2008 and beginning ministry in Nain in July.

They have a clear sense of God's call to Nain and compassionate hearts toward the needy. Please pray God's wisdom and power for the special circumstance which they will encounter.
