Cornerstone Ministry Centre (CMC) is a church with a mission. Its motto is "A heart for the city in the heart of the city."

Beginning in 1987 with a leased building on Water Street, CMC has a recognized and proven presence in the downtown of St. John's for almost 30 years. It is now housed in its own building in the Buckmaster Circle housing area and offers such outreach ministries as Coffee House and Supper Bowl, feeding and ministering to 80-100+ people every weekend in partnership with six PAONL churches. CMC also releases its facilities to such community partners as 'Strong Harbour Strings', 'Narcotics Anonymous', and 'Circus Arts'.

With a vibrant and growing congregation from both the downtown and surrounding metro region, CMC also provides PAONL's prison ministry to Her Majesty's Penitentiary. Recently, Alpha was added as an outreach and discipleship tool to the spiritually seeking. CMC has become known as one of the most welcoming environments to people of every walk of life of any church in the metro region with an intentional ministry to society's most vulnerable.

The Andrews, having been in full-time ministry since 1991, are now in their seventh year at CMC. They work alongside veteran missionaries, Pastor Rob & Tyra Winsor and their family; Pastor Rob serving as CMC's Director of Outreach. The Winsors have just begun their fifth year at CMC. CMC's goal is to bring the hope of Christ to the urban centre of St. John's.
