



Great Expectations

Note to Youth Leaders: Please distribute this information to each registrant.

We believe that attending Breakaway is an awesome privilege, but it comes with some pretty awesome – but totally reasonable – expectations for how you will behave and conduct yourself! We want Breakaway to be a positive, God honouring experience for all campers, as well as volunteers, leaders and staff. When we cooperate, show love, and demonstrate RESPECT, Breakaway will be INCREDIBLE for EVERYONE. Please read the great expectations below and commit to honouring them as you attend

Breakaway 2023.

1. ACCOMMODATIONS AREA

Under no circumstance is anyone permitted, at any time, in the designated accommodations area of the opposite sex. If violated, person(s) may be dismissed from the camp.

2. OUT OF BOUNDS

The following areas are out of bounds:

- a. Wood area on or outside of our property unless accompanied and/or authorized by Youth Breakaway staff.
- b. After curfew:
 - i. Cabin area, unless billeted there
 - ii. Ball field/basketball court
 - iii. Trailer Court
- c. Behind the following buildings:
 - i. F.G. Bursey Tabernacle
 - ii. Alice Garrigus Memorial Building
 - iii. Fred Diamond Youth Building
 - iv. Registration Building
 - v. Roy D. King Hotel building, unless billeted there.
- d. Persons found violating rules for these restricted areas will be dismissed from the Breakaway.

3. LEAVING GROUNDS

Permission is needed for anyone to leave the grounds. Only Breakaway Directors can grant permission. Leaving the grounds without permission will result in dismissal from the Breakaway.

4. ENTRANCE/EXIT

Use only the main doors and rear side doors when entering or exiting the F.G. Bursey Memorial Tabernacle.

5. ATTENTIVENESS

Attention and respect must be given to those leading morning and evening sessions at all times.

6. CAFETERIA

If any meal is not to your satisfaction speak to your chaperone who can bring it to the attention of the Breakaway Director(s). Extend appreciation and courtesy to the kitchen staff at all times.

7. AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES

It is expected that each registrant participate in the afternoon activities.

8. PROPERTY DAMAGE

The individual or group responsible must pay for any damage, deliberate or accidental. The cause of damage and cost to repair will be assessed by the Emmanuel Convention Centre administration and a bill will be issued following the camp.

9. LATENESS

In order to avoid disruption, please be on time for all activities.

10. CO-OPERATION

Obedience, co-operation and respect is to be shown at all times to chaperones and Breakaway staff.

11. VEHICLES

All vehicles are to be parked in front of the Eugene Vaters Complex. At no time are you permitted to use vehicles, unless you have been authorized by the Breakaway Director(s) to leave the grounds.

12. AUDIO EQUIPMENT

Only audio players with headphones will be permitted for private listening. All other audio equipment, e.g. amplifiers, TV's and stereos, are not permitted in the rooms. Headphones will not be permitted in morning and evening sessions.

13. DRESS CODE

You are expected to wear the following:

- a. Morning and evening services: Modest casual wear
- b. Afternoon activities: Modest active wear

14. DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION

Public and/or private displays of affection will not be tolerated.

15. CURFEW

Please adhere to the curfew indicated in your Youth Breakaway handbook.

16. CHAPERONES

Chaperones will be accommodated with/near their youth.

17. WASHROOMS

Washrooms are to be kept clean and water conserved. Appropriate disposal containers are to be used.

18. DRUGS/ALCOHOL/TOBACCO/ VAPING

The use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco will not be tolerated. Possible dismissal will result if found with these items in your possession or participating in their use.
